

Spokane Children's Theatre Safety Guidelines and Procedures

Safety guidelines and procedures are shared with all cast members, parents, employees, and volunteers.

Spokane Children's Theatre Leadership shares these expectations with cast members and parents at the required parent meeting before rehearsals start for each show. In addition, the expectations are reviewed throughout the rehearsal process as well.

- Anyone (parent volunteers, cast members, production team) over the age of 18 are required to complete a background check before every show.

- No one is allowed backstage unless they are a part of the cast/crew and have passed a background check.
-
- Security cameras have been installed throughout our theatre, backstage, rehearsal space, and lobbies since 2018.
-
- There will always be a minimum of two adults at the theatre when children are present.
-
- After rehearsals and shows parents need to come inside to pick up their child to make sure they get safely to their car.
-
- All cast members are expected to wear shorts and tank tops when they are changing in the dressing rooms. If an actor does not have these items, then they need to use a bathroom with a locked door.

These safety guidelines and procedures will be reviewed and updated as needed.
